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# [I 人間社会環境研究科(博士前期課程)]

# 1 人間社会環境研究科(博士前期課程)について

人間社会環境研究科は2006年4月に発足しました。本研究科の目的は、グローバル化、情報ネットワーク化、少子高齢化等の急速な進展に伴い、「人間」「社会」に関する既存の専門分野(人文学、経済学)並びに「環境」という概念で包括される学際的な分野(地域創造学、国際学)の知見をふまえた総合的な研究・教育のニーズに応えようとするところにあります。また、現代社会及び人々の様々な問題を理解し、解決する手段を持つ専門家を養成します。

人間社会環境研究科の3つの目標を述べましょう。第一に、専門的知識、方法、技術を修得し、政策立案と問題解決能力を有した高度専門職業人の育成及び自国の発展と国際交流に寄与できる人材の養成です。これは、社会が大学院教育に求める多様なニーズに対応しています。第二に、「人間社会環境」に関する教育研究拠点の形成です。それは、北陸地方はもちろん、日本全国における先駆けとしての学際・総合型の人文・社会系研究を根付かせ、発展させることを意味します。そして第三は、教育研究を通じた地域及び国際貢献であり、社会人学生と留学生の受入の積極的な推進などを通して、大学院レベルでの教育研究の成果を国内外の社会に還流させます。

次ページに、専攻及びコース・プログラムの編成と授与する学位を示しますが、わたくしたちの目標は、 既存の分野の学問を継承しつつ、現代的問題に的確に対処できる新たな知の営みを創造していくことです。

# [ I Admission Graduate School of Human and Socio-Environment Studies (Master's Course), Kanazawa University]

# 1 About the Graduate School of Human and Socio-Environmental Studies (Master's Program)

The Graduate School of Human and Socio-Environmental Studies was established in April 2006. The purpose of the Graduate School of Human and Socio-Environmental Studies is to meet the needs for comprehensive research and education based on the knowledge of existing specialized fields (humanities and economics) and interdisciplinary fields (regional development studies and international studies) encompassed by the concept of "environment" in response to the rapid progress of globalization, information networking, and aging society with fewer children. The Graduate School of Human and Socio-Environmental Studies also fosters professionals who understand and have the means to solve various problems facing contemporary society and people.

Through the education it provides, the Graduate School of Human and Socio-Environmental Studies has 3 goals. The first goal is to nurture advanced professionals who have acquired specialized knowledge, methods, and techniques, and who have the ability to formulate policies and solve problems, and to nurture human resources who can contribute to the development of their countries and international exchange. This corresponds to the diverse needs of society for graduate education. The second goal is the formation of an education and research center for human socio-environmental studies. This means establishing and developing interdisciplinary and comprehensive humanities and social sciences research as a pioneer not only in the Hokuriku region but also throughout Japan. And the third goal is to contribute to the regional and international community through education and research, and to return the results of education and research at the graduate level to society at home and abroad by actively promoting the acceptance of working students and international students.

The following shows the organization of divisions, courses, and programs, and the degrees to be conferred. Our goal is to create new knowledge that can accurately address contemporary issues, while continuing the existing fields of study.

# 2 学生受入方針(アドミッション・ポリシー)

人間社会環境研究科(博士前期課程)は、「人間」「社会」「環境」という多分野横断的な領域で活躍できる創造性豊かな人材の養成をめざします。したがって、研究科はそれぞれの学問分野における専門的学力を有するだけではなく、それを基礎に、学際性・総合性を生かした視点から先端的な研究をさらに進めようとする学生を求めます。

さまざまな経歴・志向を持った学生を受け入れるために、一般選抜、社会人特別選抜、外国人留学生特別選抜、学内推薦特別選抜、そして短期(1年)在学型選抜と、多様な選抜方法を実施します。

一般選抜では、大学卒業後に入学を希望する学生を主な対象として、将来的に研究者を志望する者、幅広く専門的知識を修得する者や専門的職業人をめざす者、等について十分な専門的学力と資質が備わっているか否かを判定します。

社会人特別選抜では、大学卒業後、一定の年限を経過し、社会人として様々な経験と知識を蓄積してきた人を対象に、一定の専門的学力や問題意識の明確性等について判定します。

外国人留学生特別選抜では、様々な国からの留学希望者を対象に、専門的学力について判定します。

学内推薦特別選抜は、当該専攻に係わりの深い金沢大学の関係学類の学生を対象にして、その成績優良者に記述試験を免除するものです。

人間社会環境研究科(博士前期課程)は、2年以上の在学期間を必要とする標準在学型のほか、仕事を 続けながら短期間で修士の学位を取得できる短期(1年)在学型制度を、経済学及び地域創造学の各専攻 に設けています。

短期(1年)在学型選抜は、自治体、企業、学校、非営利組織、その他において社会人としての経験をお持ちの方が、それぞれの仕事を通じて育てた問題、関心や蓄積した資料をふまえて、一定の理論的整理を行いながら論文(リサーチペーパー)をまとめることを念頭においています。修了後、博士後期課程への進学を想定するものではありません。博士後期課程への進学を希望する場合は、通常の社会人特別選抜に出願してください。

# 2 Admission Policy

The Graduate School of Human and Socio-Environmental Studies (Master's Course) aims to nurture creative individuals who can play an active role in multidisciplinary fields involving the study of humans, human society, and the environment. Therefore, the Graduate School of Human and Socio-Environmental Studies seeks students who not only possess specialized academic skills in their respective fields of study but who are also willing to further advanced research from an interdisciplinary and comprehensive perspective on the basis of these skills.

In order to accept students with a variety of backgrounds and orientations, we implement a variety of selection methods: General Selection, Special Selection for Working Adults, Special Selection for International Students, Special Selection by Recommendation for Applicants within the School, and Selection for the Short-term (1 Year) Enrollment-type System.

In General Selection, students who have graduated from universities and wish to enroll are mainly selected to determine whether they have sufficient specialized academic ability and qualifications to become researchers in the future, acquire a wide range of specialized knowledge, or become professionals.

In Special Selection for working adults, applicants who have accumulated various experiences and knowledge as a member of society after graduating from a university for a certain number of years will be screened to determine whether or not they have a certain level of specialized academic ability and a clear awareness of issues.

In the Special Selection for International Students, applicants who wish to study abroad from various countries are selected based on their specialized academic ability.

In the Special Selection by Recommendation for Applicants within the School, students from Kanazawa University whose study is closely related to the academic department in question are exempted from the written examination if they have excellent grades.

In addition to the standard program requiring at least 2 years of study, the Graduate School of Human and Socio-Environmental Studies (Master's Course) has established a Short-term (1 Year) Enrollment-type System for each major in economics and regional development studies, which enables students to obtain Master's degree in a short period while continuing working.

Selection for the Short-term (1 Year) Enrollment-type System is designed for those who have experience as working adults in local governments, corporations, schools, non-profit organizations, or the like, to compile theses (research papers) by conducting certain theoretical arrangements based on the issues, interests, and accumulated materials that they have developed through their work. Admission to the doctoral program after completing the course is not anticipated. If the applicant wishes to go on to the doctoral program, please apply for the ordinary Special Selection for Working Adults.

令和8 (2026) 年4月から、データプライバシー・エキスパート養成プログラムとして、人文学専攻ではデジタル人文コース、経済学専攻ではデジタル経済コース、地域創造学専攻ではデジタル地域創造コース及び国際学専攻ではデジタル国際コースを新設します。

当該プログラムは、個人情報等からの価値創造が遅滞しているという問題意識から、その根本原因解消を目的とします。具体的には、プライバシー保護下でのデータ分析技術の教育基盤を強化し、大学院生は個人情報等を扱う際の実務的な問題に対して、最新の知見に精通した専門家として育成します。また、人文社会科学はもとより、理工・医学系の研究者養成(社会調査や公衆衛生・疫学調査等の実践)においても不可欠な内容で構成しており、文理医の異分野融合領域におけるダブルメジャー大学院教育構築事業に位置付けています。

人間社会環境研究科(博士前期課程)では、人文学専攻、経済学専攻、地域創造学専攻そして国際学専攻の4専攻の下に多様なプログラムとコースが設けられており、入試は専攻単位で実施します。どのような教育目的・教育目標の下に、いかなる学生を受け入れようとしているのかという点については、以下に専攻別のアドミッション・ポリシーを掲げますので、確認してください。

From April 2026, as the Data Privacy Expert Development Program, the Division of Humanities will establish the Digital Humanities Study Course, the Division of Economics will establish the Digital Economic Course, the Division of Regional Development Studies will establish the Digital Regional Development Course, and the Division of International Studies will establish the Digital International Course.

This program aims to resolve the root cause of the problem of slow value creation from personal information and other sources. Specifically, the educational foundation for data analysis techniques under privacy protection will be strengthened, and graduate students will be trained as experts in the latest knowledge on practical issues when handling personal information and other data. The program also consists of essential content in humanities and social sciences, as well as in the training of researchers in science, technology, and medicine (in the practice of social research, public health, and epidemiological research, etc.), and is positioned as a program for building double major graduate school education in the interdisciplinary fields of humanities, sciences, and medicine.

The Graduate School of Human and Socio-Environmental Studies (Master's Course) offers various programs and courses under the four majors of Humanities, Economics, Regional Development Studies, and International Studies, and entrance examinations are conducted for each major. The admission policies for each major are listed below to provide a better picture of the students the school accepts under what kinds of educational objectives and goals.

# 4 Application Qualification

Eligibility for each selection includes those who meet any of the following criteria and those who are expected to meet such criteria by the time of admission to the Graduate School.

- <Common to all selections>
- (1) A person who has graduated from a university described in Article 83 of the School Education Act (No. 26 of 1947 Act)
- (2) A person who has been granted a bachelor's degree pursuant to the provisions of Article 104, Paragraph 7 of the School Education Act
- (3) A Person who has completed a 16-year course of school education with a regular curriculum in a foreign country
- (4) A person who has completed a course of an educational institution in Japan which is recognized by his or her country as having a curriculum of a university under the said country's education system and which is designated separately by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology
- (5) A person who has, while living in Japan, completed a 16-year course under the said foreign country's education system by taking subject classes at a foreign school through a distance learning system
- (6) A person who has been granted an academic degree equal to a bachelor's degree at a foreign university or other institution (limited to those institutions that have been evaluated by the foreign government or by persons who have the approval of foreign government or relevant organizations or designated separately to be an equivalent by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology in terms of comprehensive status of the education and research activities, etc.) by completing a program with a duration of study of 3 years or more (including those who have completed subject classes under a distance learning system offered by a foreign school while living in Japan or have completed a program at an educational institution in Japan that is part of the school education system of the specific country and that is separately designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology)
- (7) A person designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology
- (8) A person who has completed a higher course of a specialized training college (restricted to colleges with a duration of 4 years or longer of study and that satisfies the standards determined by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology) separately designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology after a day decided by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology
- (9) A person who has enrolled in a graduate school of another university pursuant to the provisions of Article 102, Paragraph 2 of the School Education Act and then who is recognized to have appropriate abilities to receive graduate school education at a graduate school of Kanazawa University.



### (3) 本学が義務付けている学生保険

本学では、学生生活における事故に備え、学生教育研究災害傷害保険(学研災)及び学研災付帯 賠償責任保険(付帯賠責)(外国人留学生は、学生教育研究災害傷害保険(学研災)及び外国人留学 生向け学研災付帯学生生活総合保険(インバウンド付帯学総))への加入を義務付けています。いず れの保険も、全国の大学・短期大学の学生を対象とし、公益財団法人日本国際教育支援協会が取り 扱っている補償制度です。未加入の場合、課外活動、教育実習、インターンシップ等を許可しない ことがあります。

保険料の納付は、後日公表する入学手続要項を確認してください。

学研災:国内外において、①教育研究活動中に生じた急激かつ偶然な外来の事故、②通学中、学校施設等での移動中の事故によって身体に被る傷害(ケガ)に対して保険金が支払われます。

付帯賠責:国内外において、正課、学校行事、課外活動又はその往復において、他人にケガを負わせた場合、他人の財物を損壊した場合等により、法律上の損害賠償責任を 負担することによって被る損害に対し保険金が支払われます。本学では、全学生 (留学生を除く)に対し、付帯賠責と学研災の両方への加入が必須です。

外国人留学生は、付帯賠責への加入は不要ですが、代えてインバウンド付帯学総への加入が必須です。

なお、付帯賠責での「課外活動」は、大学がインターンシップ又はボランティア活動の実施を活動目的として承認した団体が行うインターンシップ又はボランティア活動のことをいいます。

### (3) Compulsory Student Insurance

To cover possible accidents during student life, Kanazawa University requires students to obtain Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research (Gakkensai) and Liability Insurance (Futai Baiseki). International students are required to be covered by the Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research (Gakkensai) and the Comprehensive Insurance for Students Lives Coupled with Gakkensai for International Students (Inbound Futai Gakuso). Both types of insurance are for students of universities and colleges throughout Japan and are provided by Japan Educational Exchanges and Services. Students who do not have insurance may not be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities, educational training, internships, etc.

For payment of premiums, please check the enrollment procedure guidelines to be published at a later date.

Gakkensai: In Japan and overseas, this insurance provides coverage against (1) sudden and accidental outpatient injuries that occur during educational and research activities and injuries that occur while commuting or while at institutional facilities.

Futai Baiseki: In Japan and overseas, this insurance provides coverage against legal damages for injuries inflicted on others, property damage, etc., during regular academic operations, academic events, extracurricular activities or travel. Students are required to have both Gakkensai and Futai Baiseki.

International Students are not required to obtain Futai Baiseki, but are required to obtain Inbound Futai Gakuso.

Unlike "extracurricular activities" in Gakkensai, "extracurricular activities" in Futaibaiseki refers to internships or volunteer activities conducted by organizations approved by the university for the purpose of conducting internships or volunteer activities.

### (5)【大学院(教職大学院及び法科大学院を除く)対象】修了要件としての英語外部検定試験

# (5) [For Graduate School (excluding Professional Graduate Schools and Law School)] English Language Proficiency Tests

As a part of efforts to strengthen English language skills, each graduate school, in principle, requires students to obtain a score on an external English language examination that meets a certain standard (\*1) after admission as one of the requirements for completion of the program.

However, students who meet any of the following criteria are exempted from taking the English proficiency test. In order to be exempted, you must submit an Application for Exemption from the English Proficiency Test and undergo an examination. The examination fee is to be paid by the student.

- [1] Those who have a score (\*2) in TOEIC (L&R), TOEFL-IBT, TOEFL-ITP, etc., above a certain level
- [2] Those who have been admitted through the special selection for working adults or the Short-term (1-year) Enrollment-type System for students with disabilities.
- [3] Those who fall under short-term (1 year) enrollment after admission
- [4] Native English speakers (those who were born and raised in a country where English is generally the official language and who have acquired English as their first language)
- [5] Those who were admitted through the English-language selection examination for the Graduate School of Law, Division of Law and Politics
- [6] Others who are approved by the Dean of the Graduate School.
  - \*1: TOEIC(L&R) 600 points equivalent
  - \*2: TOEIC(L&R) 760 or above or TOEFL-iBT 80 or above or TOEFL-ITP 550 or above or IELTS 6.0 or above

### (6) 【大学院対象】大学院設置基準第14条に基づく教育方法の特例制度

在職者等必要がある者に対して、大学院での学修を容易とするための「大学院設置基準第14条に基づく教育方法の特例」の制度があります。この制度を利用することで、各研究科規程等に定められた教育課程に基づき、担当指導教員の許可・指導の下で弾力的に学修することができます。

制度の適用を希望する場合は、入学志願票の14条特例希望欄に☑を入れてください。また、「受験承諾書」を提出してください。なお、本学は同第2条の2(専ら夜間において教育を行う大学院の課程)には該当しません。

第14条 大学院の課程においては、教育上特別の必要があると認められる場合には、夜間その 他特定の時間又は時期において授業又は研究指導を行う等の適当な方法により教育を 行うことができる。

### (7)【大学院対象】長期履修制度

仕事あるいは家事、育児、介護等に従事している人たちのために、標準修業年限を超えて履修を認める特別な制度(長期履修制度)を設けています(短期(1年)在学型制度適用者を除く)。この制度を利用すれば、大学院学則に規定される在学年限※の範囲内で、長期履修期間を設定することができます。授業料は、標準修業年限の授業料総額を長期履修として認められた期間に学期ごとに均分して支払うことになります。ただし、在学中に授業料が改訂された場合は、改訂後の授業料に基づき計算されます。

対象となる学生は次のいずれかに該当する者で、標準就業年限内での修学が困難な事情にあるものです。

# (6) [For Graduate School] Special exception for educational methods based on Article 14 of the Standards for the Establishment of Graduate Schools

The Graduate School offers a system of a Special Exception for Educational Methods Based on Article 14 of the Standards for the Establishment of Graduate Schools to facilitate graduate study for those who need it, such as those who are currently employed. By using this system, students can flexibly study under the permission and guidance of their academic advisor based on the curriculum stipulated in the regulations of the Graduate School of Human and Socio-Environmental Studies.

If you wish to apply for this system, please check  $\square$  the Special Exception column of Article 14 on the application form. In addition, please submit a Letter of Consent for Examination (Form 2). Please note that Article 2-2 (Graduate courses offered exclusively in the evening) does not apply. The graduate school offers day/evening courses.

Reference: Standard for Establishment of Graduate School (Order of the Ministry of Education, Science and Culture No.28, 1974) (Extract)

Article 14: In the curriculum of the graduate school, if necessary from an educational standpoint, the education may be conducted by an appropriate method through classes or research guidance at night or other specific time or period.

### (7) **[For Graduate School]** Long-term enrollment system

For those who are engaged in work, housework, childcare, nursing care, etc., a special system (long-term enrollment system) is available to allow students to take courses beyond the standard length of study (except for those who apply for the Short-term (1-year) Enrollment-type System). Excluding Selection for the Short-term (1 Year) Enrollment-type System, the Graduate School offers a long-term enrollment system that allows an enrollment beyond the limit of standard course of study for people with other responsibilities such as full-time work, housework, child-rearing, nursing for family members, and so on.

Through this system, the student's enrollment period can be extended within the limit set in the Graduate School Rules \*.

Total tuition amount is the same as that of standard course of study (master's course section: two years) and can be paid in parts while enrolled.

Eligible students must fall into one of the following categories and have difficulty completing their studies within the standard working years.

- (a) Those who are gainfully employed (including temporary employment)
- (b) Those who are engaged in housework, childcare, nursing care, etc.
- (c)Those who have physical disabilities, intellectual disabilities, mental disabilities (including developmental disabilities), or other physical or mental functional disabilities.

If you wish to apply, please put a  $\square$  in the "Long-term Enrollment System Preference" box on the application form.

Applications from students who wish to take long-term courses may not be approved in some cases.

### 7 Protection of Personal Information

Kanazawa University has established regulations on personal information management to properly manage and protect the information it holds.

All personal information obtained by the University at the time of admission selection, during the admission process, and after enrollment will be used for the following purposes, etc:

- (1) Operations related to candidate selection and enrollment
- (2) Operations related to enrollment management, study instructions, and health management such as medical examinations after admission
- (3) Operations related to on-campus services such as the University's portal site, campus LAN, library, and borrowing library books after enrollment
- (4) Services related to school support such as entrance fee reduction, tuition fee reduction, and scholarship procedures, etc.
- (5) Operations related to the payment of admission fees, tuition, and the operations of the financial institution to which the University outsources payment collection
- (6) Statistical processing, research work, and presentations at academic conferences for the purpose of contributing to entrance examination and educational reforms in a form that does not identify individuals
- (7) Operations related to PR targeting students and their families, and related to funds (donations)
- (8) Operations related to outcome assessments for the graduates and those related to alumni relations, and information services through Kanazawa University
- (9) Services related to emergency response for the protection of individuals, etc.
- (10) Statistical work conducted in such a way that no individuals can be identified



#### Hokuriku Railroad Bus
